

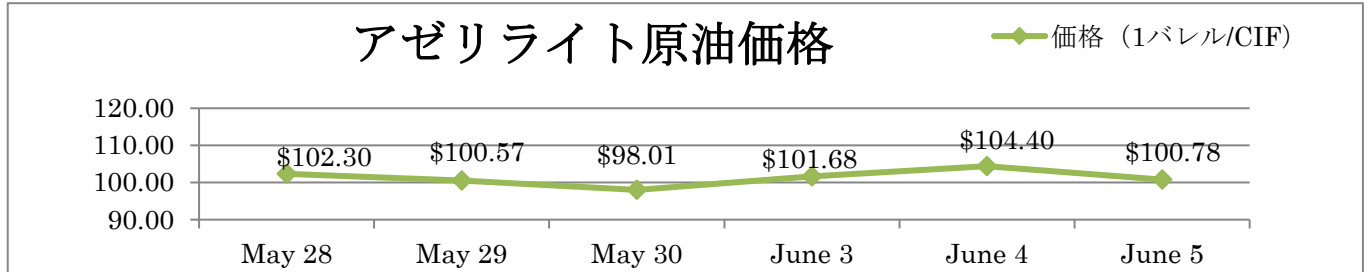

1. エネルギー・環境



●第一回アゼルバイジャン・米国経済対話がバクーエネルギーウィークの場で開催

On June 2, the first U.S.-Azerbaijan Economic Dialogue, jointly organized by the Ministry of Economy of Azerbaijan and the U.S. Department of State, will convene on the sidelines of Baku Energy Week in accordance with the U.S.-Azerbaijan Charter on Strategic Partnership, the US Embassy in Azerbaijan said. The event aims to advance cooperation on regional connectivity, trade, industry, transit, energy security, investment, artificial intelligence, and digital infrastructure. The U.S. and Azerbaijani business communities will also participate in a special session of the Dialogue, which will feature the signing of several cooperation documents and commercial deals. Baku Energy Week started in Baku on June 1 and will continue until June 3. Baku Energy Week combines 3 events: the 31st International Caspian Oil and Gas Exhibition - Caspian Oil and Gas, the 14th Caspian International Clean Energy Exhibition - Caspian Power and the 31st Baku Energy Forum. This year's event features 276 companies from 46 countries.

President Aliyev attended the official opening ceremony of the 31st International Caspian Oil and Gas Exhibition - Caspian Oil and Gas, the 14th Caspian International Clean Energy Exhibition - Caspian Power, and the 31st Baku Energy Forum, held at the Baku Expo Center as part of Baku Energy Week. Addressing the event, President Aliyev said:

- Baku Energy Week really is one of the leading events in the global energy arena. I'm very grateful to President Trump, President Erdoğan of Türkiye and UK Prime Minister Starmer for their kind messages to the event.
- President Trump deserves additional gratitude for bringing the energy trend back to normality. As we all know, for many years countries and companies involved in oil and gas production have been demonized and sometimes blackmailed, accused of ruining the planet, and without any grounds, cornered in public opinion. President Trump changed that trend. The world cannot live without fossil fuels. We all want to have a better climate and

save the planet. But today we must be very pragmatic and, based on realism, plan our future with respect to energy security while also investing in renewables. I think that what is happening now in the global energy arena was really generated by the very wise and pragmatic policy of the U.S. President. And once again, we are all very grateful to him.

- If we look back at 1994, we will see that Azerbaijan was in very bad shape. If we look at Azerbaijan today and see this transformation, how we used this wealth, how we reinvested in social infrastructure, education, healthcare, and energy development, we will see that this is how countries should develop. We have already achieved an investment-grade rating. The poverty level has been reduced to 5%. Unemployment is around the same figure. Today, we have one of the lowest levels of foreign debt in the world, amounting to just over 6% of our GDP. Our reserves in State Oil Fund and Central Bank exceed our foreign debt by more than 18 times. All this happened, first, because we properly used our natural resources. So, natural resources, when properly used, can generate many advantages.
- We all talk about energy security. Especially now, when the crisis in the Middle East has largely damaged the energy security of many countries, producers, and consumers. We worked on that for many years. We invested heavily and initiated large-scale infrastructure projects such as the Baku-Tbilisi-Ceyhan oil pipeline, Baku-Supsa oil pipeline, TANAP and TAP, which, together with the South Caucasus Gas Pipeline, are part of the Southern Gas Corridor. Today, the corridor provides energy security for a growing number of countries. Today, it is difficult to imagine what the European energy market would look like without the Southern Gas Corridor. Last year, we had 12 recipient countries of Azerbaijani gas. Today, that number is 16, and 10 of them are members of the European Union. And the number will definitely grow.
- 30 years ago, we were attracting investors. Now we are taking our investments abroad. Today, SOCAR, is investing in the Middle East, Africa, and Central Asia. And this geography will continue to expand.
- We are providing crucial transit opportunities for our friends and partners who live on the eastern shores of the Caspian. Oil from Central Asia is moving through Azerbaijan's territory to international markets. I hope the time will come when the same will be true for natural gas.
- We have created a very diversified downstream capacity. Today, SOCAR's refining capacity exceeds 30 million tons. And through the recent acquisition of Italiana Petroli, our refining capacity in the Mediterranean increased from 13 million to 23 million tons. So we not only provide oil and gas, but also oil products. We also export electricity, petrochemicals, and renewable energy.
- With our gas reserves, which will be sufficient for at least 100 years—not only for us but also for our clients—we actually do not need any other source of electricity generation. But our responsibility dictates that we invest in renewables. And we are doing that, together with our partners. By the end of next year, we will have 2 gigawatts of solar and wind capacity. By the end of 2032, we will have 8 gigawatts of solar and wind capacity. And if we add hydropower, which we are actively developing, especially in the liberated areas of

Garabagh and East Zangezur, where more than 300 megawatts have already been commissioned, this represents additional potential.

- Today, we are working closely with our partners on energy cables - Black Sea Energy Cable, which will stretch from Azerbaijan to Georgia, under the Black Sea, to Romania, Hungary, and many other countries, as well as on another project, the onshore electric cable connecting Azerbaijan, Georgia, Türkiye, and Bulgaria.

●アゼリ・チラグ・グナシリ（ACG）油田から非随伴ガスが生産開始

On June 1, bp, as operator of the ACG field development, announced on behalf of the ACG co-venturers – SOCAR, MOL, INPEX, ExxonMobil, TPAO and ONGC Videsh – the commencement of non-associated gas (NAG) production operations on the ACG field in the Azerbaijan sector of the Caspian Sea. This marks the first-ever commercial gas production operations on ACG, one of the world's largest oil-producing fields. The initial NAG well, drilled from the existing West Chirag platform, is a critical first step in unlocking ACG's significant non-associated gas resource potential. As well as delivering early production, the well provides important reservoir and flow data, supporting appraisal of the resource base to inform future full-field gas development. The NAG resources of ACG are believed to be significant, with an estimated 4 trillion cubic feet of recoverable reserves and a potential upside to 6 trillion cubic feet. The first NAG operations are focused on the Qirmaki Lower Sand reservoir for an initial period of well and reservoir testing activities. Gas and condensate produced from the well will be directed to the Sangachal terminal via the existing ACG infrastructure. (Azertag, 01.06.2026)

On June 1, President Aliyev received a U.S. delegation led by Caleb Orr, Assistant Secretary of State for Economic, Energy, and Business Affairs. Noting that bilateral relations have been developing successfully in recent times, the head of state touched upon the importance of the Strategic Partnership Charter signed between Azerbaijan and the United States, as well as the creation of working groups on various fields based on this Charter to develop cooperation. He emphasized that the first meeting of the Azerbaijan-US Economic Dialogue would be held. Caleb Orr emphasized that Donald Trump's sending a letter to Baku Energy Week demonstrated the importance the United States attaches to the event. During the meeting, it was emphasized that Baku Energy Week is a successful platform for exchanging views on global energy issues, as well as for discussing the prospects of cooperation among the world's leading energy companies, government agencies, investors, and industry experts. ●グループ 8（トルコ、パキスタン、イラン、エジプト、インドネシア、バングラデシュ、マレーシア及びナイジェリア）のエネルギー大臣会合がバクーで開催

As part of Baku Energy Week, the first meeting of energy ministers from the Development Group of Eight (D-8) was held on June 1. Speaking at a session on the topic “Expanding Cooperation in Hydrocarbons, Energy Transition, and Energy Interconnections,” Azerbaijan’s Minister of Energy Parviz Shahbazov noted that Azerbaijan’s membership in the D-8 is a logical continuation of the multi-vector foreign policy course. The D-8 platform opens up important opportunities for Azerbaijan to expand energy cooperation not only with Europe but also with Asia, the Middle East, and Africa, he said. The Minister provided information on ongoing and planned projects with Türkiye, Pakistan, Iran, Egypt, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Malaysia, and Nigeria. Potential areas of energy cooperation identified included oil and gas trade, LNG supplies, electricity exchange, renewable energy, energy infrastructure, and investments. The D-8 Platform, which brings together countries sharing common religious and cultural values and spans three continents, paves the way for taking cooperation to a broader level in such critical areas as energy security, the energy transition, and energy connectivity, the Minister told. The Baku Declaration on Energy Cooperation was adopted during the meeting, and a preliminary presentation of the Charter of the “D-8 Energy and Climate Center” took place. (Trend, 01.06.2026)

Last year, Azerbaijan accounted for 8.1% of the European Union’s pipeline gas imports, Minister of Energy Parviz Shahbazov said at the plenary session of ministers on “International Cooperation for a Resilient and Diversified Energy Future,” held as part of Baku Energy Week on June 1. “Azerbaijan supplies oil to more than 20 countries, and the number of countries receiving Azerbaijani natural gas has reached 16, making it one of the world leaders in terms of the geographical reach of its pipeline gas exports,” the Minister said. “Over the past year and the first four months of this year, Azerbaijan exported 16.7 billion cubic meters of gas to Europe, 12.8 billion cubic meters to Turkey, 3.3 billion cubic meters to Georgia, and 800 million cubic meters to Syria,” he added. ●バハル及びグムデニズ油田の再開発を開始

Bahar Energy Operating Company (BEOC) has launched the implementation of a project for the redevelopment of the Bahar and Gum-Deniz fields located in Azerbaijan's sector of the Caspian Sea. As a result of the operational measures carried out, gas production at the Bahar field has increased by 50%. As part of the project, international energy services company SLB has been engaged to conduct technical and geological assessment work. It was noted that the initial technical and geological assessment phases have been completed, and the project is currently proceeding toward the next stage of development. Within this framework, the potential of the fields and future infrastructure requirements are being assessed. (Apa, 03.06.2026)

The first Azerbaijan–U.S. Economic Dialogue, jointly organized by the Ministry of Economy of Azerbaijan and the U.S. Department of State, convened on June 2 on the sidelines of Baku Energy Week. Co-chaired by Azerbaijani Minister of Economy Mikayil Jabbarov and U.S. Assistant Secretary of State for Economic, Energy, and Business Affairs Caleb Orr, Economic Dialogue brought together representatives from governments, international financial organizations, and the private sector to explore opportunities to boost bilateral economic and commercial cooperation under the auspices of the U.S.-Azerbaijan Charter on Strategic Partnership. The First Economic Dialogue featured panel sessions on regional connectivity, trade and transit, energy security, investment, artificial intelligence, and digital infrastructure.

- During the regional connectivity, trade and transit session, participants discussed the Trump Route for International Peace and Prosperity, the Trans-Caspian Trade Route, the expansion of regional logistics capabilities, Azerbaijan's favorable business environment for investors, and the opportunities for U.S. businesses created by Azerbaijan's growing connectivity with Europe and Central Asia.
- During the energy security session, participants explored opportunities for cooperation in the development of the Southern Gas Corridor, electricity interconnections, and energy production. Participants emphasized the importance of diversification of critical minerals

supply chains and cooperation on mining, minerals processing, surveying, and other issues.

- The panel on economic investment focused on promoting two-way investment in transport and logistics, energy, and digital technologies.
- The artificial intelligence and digital infrastructure panel highlighted world-class U.S. technology solutions and explored opportunities for cooperation on data centers, AI applications, and the development of regulatory frameworks conducive to tech investment. Both parties emphasized the importance of expanding partnerships and promoting two-way investments to support innovative projects and a growing digital ecosystem.
- Within the framework of the event, meetings were also held with business representatives, and the importance of developing cooperation within the private sector and establishing new partnerships was emphasized.
- Minister of Economy Mikayil Jabbarov and Assistant Secretary for Economic, Energy and Business Affairs at the U.S. Department of State Caleb Orr witnessed signing of several documents in the field of establishment of digital infrastructure in Azerbaijan, technology transfer, the implementation of efficient industrial solutions.

●シャフデニズガス田がプロジェクト開始 30周年を迎える

Shah Deniz is celebrating its 30th anniversary in 2026. This is an important milestone for the Government of Azerbaijan, bp and Shah Deniz partners. According to bp, in 2025, the field produced around 27 billion standard cubic metres of gas and about 4 million tonnes (around 32 million barrels) of condensate in total from the Shah Deniz Alpha and Shah Deniz Bravo platforms. Since the start of production till the end of 1Q 2026, Shah Deniz produced 271 billion cubic metres of gas and about 53 million tonnes of condensate. Shah Deniz wells rank among the top in bp's global portfolio, with 17 of the company's 20 highest-producing wells coming from the field, underscoring its exceptional reservoir quality and operational excellence. The current top producer Shah Deniz well produces 28 thousand barrels of oil equivalent per day. A total of 34 wells – 11 on Shah Deniz 1 and 23 on Shah Deniz 2 – have been drilled to date. Out of them, 32 wells are currently producing. Around 271 bcm of Shah Deniz gas has been exported through SCP and SCPx since 2006, including the domestic market. Capital expenditure in the Shah Deniz project by the end of 1Q 2026 was \$31 billion. (Azertag, 04.06.2026)

●BP と SOCAR がカスピ海のアゼルバイジャン領域で収集された海洋地震探査データのデータベース化につき協力

bp and SOCAR are jointly implementing a project aimed at consolidating all marine seismic data collected in Azerbaijan's sector of the Caspian Sea into a unified database. The announcement was made by Dan Sparks during a panel discussion held on the second day of Baku Energy Week. According to Sparks, the initiative is designed to identify existing seismic data gaps in the

Caspian basin and improve the efficiency of future exploration activities. “bp and SOCAR are currently working on consolidating all existing marine seismic data in the Caspian sector of Azerbaijan into one large database. This will create an important basis for future exploration work,” he stated. The project is expected to support future offshore exploration efforts and strengthen Azerbaijan’s long-term energy development strategy in the Caspian region. (Azer News, 02.06.2026)

●EBRD によるアゼルバイジャンの経済成長率予測 2026年2%、2027年2.5%

Azerbaijan’s economic growth is expected to increase to 2% in 2026 and 2.5% in 2027, EBRD said. The report emphasizes that Azerbaijan’s economic growth outlook remains dependent on oil and gas prices as well as production volumes. The conflict in the Middle East could raise global energy prices, generating additional revenue for the country and creating opportunities for spending and investment that support economic growth. The EBRD also stated that the peace framework reached with Armenia through U.S. mediation could expand regional transport and trade links, while large-scale investments in renewable energy could support economic diversification and growth in the medium term. ●アリエフ大統領が中銀の新棟を視察

On June 3, President Aliyev attended the inauguration of the new building of the Central Bank. Governor of the Central Bank Taleh Kazimov briefed the head of state on the facilities available in the building. The new building, located on Heydar Aliyev Avenue in Baku and designed in line with urban planning principles, combines high functionality with advanced technological features. Designed for a workforce of 1,300, the 35-story building houses conference and press halls, as well as various meeting and training spaces. (Azertag, 04.06.2026)

●アグダム産業パークにプラスチックリサイクル会社が新たに入居

A new resident of Aghdam Industrial Park will implement a project to recycle plastic waste and produce corrugated and high-pressure-resistant polyethylene pipes. According to Economic Zones Development Agency under the Economy Ministry of Azerbaijan, Ceer Plastik LLC has been granted resident status in the park managed by the Agency. The investment value of the project is 5 million manats (\$2.9 million). So far, 31 business entities have been granted resident status and five entrepreneurs non-resident status in Aghdam Industrial Park. Entrepreneurs have invested more than 172 million manats (\$101.2 million) in projects implemented in the park, creating over 1,000 jobs. The park, which ranks second in the country by number of residents, exports its products in addition to supplying local demand. (report.az, 04.06.2026)

Official opening of new Baku-Tbilisi-Kars railway line was held on June 2. Georgia's Prime Minister Irakli Kobakhidze, Minister of Economy and Sustainable Development Mariam Kvirivshvili, Azerbaijan's Minister of Digital Development and Transport Rashad Nabiyeu, and Türkiye's Minister of Transport and Infrastructure Abdulkadir Uraloğlu, members of the Georgian government, members of the Parliament, representatives of the diplomatic corps and partner nations, along with Armenia's Minister of Territorial Administration and Infrastructure, Davit Khudatyan, as well as guests from Uzbekistan and Kazakhstan attended the ceremony. According to Georgia's Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development, once fully operational, the line's capacity is expected to reach 5 million tonnes, enabling the region to handle additional cargo and significantly boost its transport capabilities. ●ババエフ財務大臣が世銀南コーカサス地域局長と会談 経済の多角化等注力事項につき議論

On June 2, Minister of Finance Sahil Babayev met with Rolande Pryce, World Bank Regional Director for the South Caucasus. During the meeting, the World Bank presented its report, "Diversification and Development in Azerbaijan" and the parties discussed the report's key findings and its potential implications for the country's economic diversification efforts. The parties also reviewed ongoing efforts to enhance the corporate governance of state-owned enterprises, improve transparency and accountability, strengthen monitoring mechanisms, and ensure the effective management of fiscal risks. Rolande Pryce noted the World Bank's interest in further expanding collaboration in areas such as private sector development, green growth, energy transition, digitalization, public sector governance, and human capital development. The meeting concluded with an exchange of views on economic and financial issues of mutual interest, with both sides reaffirming the importance of continued cooperation and constructive dialogue. Silk Way West Airlines, the leading cargo airline in the Caspian and Central Asian region, has entered into a new multi-year agreement with dnata, a global air and travel services provider, for cargo and freighter handling services at Singapore Changi Airport. Under the agreement, dnata will support Silk Way West Airlines' twice-weekly freighter services at one of Asia's key aviation and logistics hubs. The partnership is expected to cover more than 100 freighter flights annually and over 15,000 tonnes of cargo each year, including general freight, temperature-sensitive goods, and specialized shipments such as oil and gas, aviation and aerospace equipment. ●**780TEU 規模のコンテナ船の竜骨設置式がバクー造船所で開催 中央回廊向け**

A keel-laying ceremony has been held at Baku Shipyard for the first of two container vessels with a capacity of 780 TEU that will operate on the Caspian Sea. The project is being implemented as part of a strategic cooperation initiative between Azerbaijan and the UAE. Each vessel will have the following specifications: Length: 149.5 meters; Beam (width): 21 meters; Deadweight: 9,404 tons; Cargo hold capacity: 16,722 cubic meters; Container capacity: 780 TEU. The ships will be equipped with hybrid propulsion systems incorporating technologies from Wärtsilä and SCHOTTEL, aimed at improving fuel efficiency and reducing emissions. Delivery of the vessels is scheduled by 2028. Once commissioned, the new container ships are expected to strengthen the Middle Corridor. (report.az, 04.06.2026)

●**トルコの交通インフラ大臣によるとザンゲズル回廊（TRIPP）のアゼルバイジャン部分はほぼ完成 アルメニアとの国境付近の 40km 程度を残すのみ**

Work on Azerbaijan's section of Zangezur Corridor is nearing completion, Türkiye's Minister of Transport and Infrastructure Abdulkadir Uraloğlu said on June 3. The Minister noted that work on Zangezur Corridor project is continuing and that Türkiye has begun construction on its section. According to him, the tender for the 224-kilometer Kars–Iğdır–Aralık–Dilucu railway line located on the Turkish side has been completed and construction has started. Work on the approximately 180-kilometer railway line in Nakhchivan is also planned to continue this year. "Work on the Azerbaijani side is also nearing completion, and some sections have already been finished. What remains unfinished is the 41- or 43-kilometer Zangezur passage, namely the section passing through Armenia. As you know, it is sometimes referred to as the 'Trump Corridor.' We expect the process to begin there with the agreement of the United States and Azerbaijan," Uraloğlu said. The Minister added that once completed, a total transport route of 860 kilometers will become

operational, creating a shorter connection between Türkiye and the Turkic world as well as Central Asia. (Apa, 03.06.2026)

Another 30 Ukrainian children have been brought to Azerbaijan to receive social and psychological rehabilitation services under a program organized by the Social Services Agency operating under the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of the Population. Within the framework of the 10-day program, the children will first participate in group therapy sessions, meditation and yoga classes, as well as various psychosocial trainings and workshops at a camp located in Baku.
