

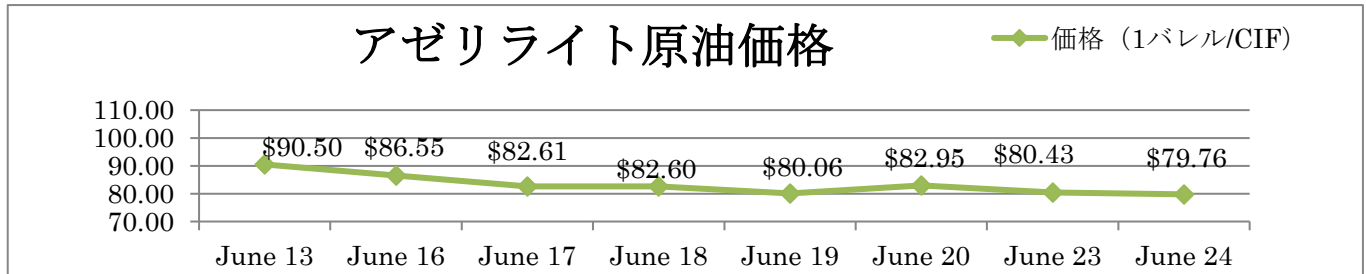

1. エネルギー・環境



●NEQSOL ホールディングとウズベキスタン鉱業地質省がウズベキスタンにおける重要鉱物採掘に関する協力に合意

NEQSOL Holding has signed a cooperation agreement with the Ministry of Mining Industry and Geology of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the joint development of critical minerals in Uzbekistan, including strategic raw materials such as titanium. The signing took place in the broader context of Azerbaijan-Uzbekistan investment dialogue during the 5th Tashkent International Investment Forum (TIIF2026). Yusif Jabbarov, Chairman of the Board of NEQSOL Holding, signed the cooperation agreement during the official signing ceremony of bilateral documents between Azerbaijan and Uzbekistan, held with the participation of Prime Minister of Azerbaijan Ali Asadov and Prime Minister of Uzbekistan Abdulla Aripov. As part of the TIIF2026, Yusif Jabbarov also participated in the Azerbaijani delegation's meeting with the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Shavkat Mirziyoyev. The meeting provided an opportunity to exchange views on priority areas for investment cooperation and long-term partnership potential between Azerbaijan and Uzbekistan. (Trend, 23.06.2026)

●Azneft 生産協会所有の海底パイプライン損傷がピララヒ及びドウベンディ（注：いずれもバクー郊外）海岸への原油流出・汚染の原因 SOCAR 発表

On June 19, relevant services of the central office of SOCAR's Azneft Production Union received information about traces of oil pollution observed in the area of Dubendi beach, SOCAR told. An oil slick was detected during an initial inspection carried out by vessels and a helicopter in the water area between Pirallahi Island and Dubendi. It was noted that since no active point of oil leakage was visually detected at the initial stage of the incident, several possible sources of pollution were considered. As a result of controlled diagnostic inspections, the source of the pollution was identified as one of the underwater oil pipelines belonging to Azneft Production Union. Immediately after the leak source was identified, oil transportation through the pipeline was suspended. An operational headquarters was established by Azneft Production Union to manage the incident, and the situation was brought under control. Diagnostic measures conducted by Azneft's diving service revealed mechanical damage to the underwater oil pipeline. According to the preliminary assessment, the damage was caused by contact with an external object, most likely an anchor. "Repair and restoration work began immediately after the damage

was detected. Until these works are completed, the damaged pipeline will remain out of operation, preventing further oil leakage into the sea. Efforts to eliminate the consequences of the incident, including the cleaning of the sea and coastal areas, are being carried out in close coordination between the Ministry of Emergency Situations and Azneft Production Union,” the statement said. ●アゼルバイジャンが COP31 に向け気候変動プロセスに関し信頼強化を呼びかけ 野心的な気候目標の達成へ

“Strengthening trust in the negotiation process within the framework of the COP is essential to achieving more ambitious climate targets,” said COP29 President and Representative of the President of Azerbaijan on Climate Issues Mukhtar Babayev during his speech at the High-Level Ministerial Dialogue titled “Riding the Wave: Ocean-Climate from Mombasa to Antalya,” held as part of London Climate Action Week 2026. Babayev noted that although many green projects are technically feasible, their implementation in developing countries is hindered by high financing costs. According to him, the cost of capital in these countries is often two to three times higher than in developed economies. Citing the Caspian region as an example, the COP29 President said that the water level of the Caspian Sea—the world’s largest inland body of water—has been declining by more than 20 centimeters per year in recent years. “This trend creates additional challenges not only for the Caspian littoral states but also for the development of the Middle Corridor, which connects Asia and Europe and is gaining increasing strategic importance.” Babayev also stated that Azerbaijan continues to provide financial and organizational support to the most climate-vulnerable developing small island states. He emphasized that Azerbaijan, together with the Commonwealth Secretariat, has committed to allocating \$10 million over five years for projects to be implemented in climate-vulnerable small island states. “This initiative aims to strengthen these countries’ capacity to adapt to climate change and enhance their resilience.” In conclusion, Babayev noted that oceans, seas, and water systems clearly demonstrate the impact of climate change on the economy, infrastructure, and security, serving as a reminder of the severe consequences of delaying climate action. ●東欧向け気候週間のバクー開催に向けて初期協議を実施

During meetings held on the sidelines of London Climate Action Week, the organization of Climate Week for Eastern Europe in Baku was discussed, and initial consultations on the event were held. It was noted that one of the main objectives of Azerbaijan’s participation in London Climate Action Week was to launch initial discussions on organizing Climate Week for Eastern Europe, conduct consultations with potential partners, and agree on the main directions of the program. As part of London Climate Action Week, Mukhtar Babayev, Representative of the President of Azerbaijan on Climate Issues, met with United Nations Secretary-General António Guterres. During the meeting, the Secretary-General highly appreciated the outcomes achieved during COP29 and expressed his satisfaction with the results. Guterres emphasized that the experience gained by Azerbaijan during its COP29 Presidency is of great importance for future climate processes. He noted the importance of sharing this experience with Türkiye, which will host COP31, as well as with subsequent COP presidencies. The meeting highlighted Azerbaijan’s active role in advancing the global climate agenda. The sides exchanged views on combating climate change, expanding international cooperation, and integrating the legacy of COP29 into future climate processes. (Azertag, 26.06.2026)

●カザフスタンがアゼルバイジャンを含む複数国（中国、トルクメニスタン等）から航空燃料輸入を検討

Kazakhstan is considering importing aviation fuel from Azerbaijan, China and Turkmenistan as part of efforts to diversify its fuel supply sources. Kazakhstan's Energy Minister Erlan Aqkenjenov announced that the country's Ministry of Energy is evaluating several options for importing aviation fuel from abroad. "We are considering importing aviation fuel from Turkmenistan, as well as from neighboring countries such as Azerbaijan," Aqkenjenov said. (Azer News, 26.06.2026)

●ジョージアが 20 億立方メートル以上の天然ガスの輸入枠をアゼルバイジャンから確保

The Government of Georgia has secured a guarantee for the supply of more than 2 billion cubic meters of natural gas from Azerbaijan at favorable prices, Prime Minister Irakli Kobakhidze announced while presenting the government's annual performance report to parliament. The prime minister emphasized that negotiations with Azerbaijan on this strategically important issue were successfully concluded: "We held extremely important talks with our friendly country, Azerbaijan, regarding gas supplies, which are of fundamental importance for Georgia. The Ministry of Economy successfully completed these negotiations, resulting in a guarantee for the supply of more than 2 billion cubic meters of gas at favorable prices.", he said adding that the agreement is of great significance for strengthening Georgia's energy security. ●中銀が政策金利を 6.5%に据置き

On June 24, Management Board of the Central Bank of Azerbaijan (CBA) decided to keep the refinancing rate unchanged at 6.5%. According to the CBA, the floor of the interest rate corridor remains at 5.5%, while the ceiling stays at 7.5%. The CBA stated that the decision was based on the stabilization of actual and projected inflation within the target range, as well as consideration of the geopolitical situation, global financial market trends, and domestic macroeconomic conditions. ●漁業部門の近代化に向けた法案が準備中 漁業管理のデジタル化、情報システムを通じた漁業主体・資源・流通製品の登録と追跡を行うための仕組みを確立へ

A new draft law "On Fisheries" has been prepared. The draft law was discussed at the meeting of the Agrarian Policy Committee of the Parliament on June 25. The draft law consists of 8 chapters and 30 articles. According to the draft, mechanisms will be established for the digitalization of fisheries management and for the registration and tracking of fisheries entities, the resources used, and products placed into circulation through information systems. Information

on fisheries entities and facilities, fisheries infrastructure, fishing gear, fishing vessels, and other data necessary for the implementation of management and supervision in the fisheries sector will be collected in the information system of the body (institution) designated by the relevant executive authority, taking into account the requirements of the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan "On Personal Data." Information on fisheries water bodies, including fishing grounds, will be transferred from the information system of the body (institution) designated by the relevant executive authority to the information system of the body (institution) designated by the relevant executive authority in order to ensure the completeness of the data contained in the state cadastre and the state register of real estate. The draft provides for the determination of quotas for the use of fish stocks on a scientific basis, transparency in the issuance of fishing permits, real-time monitoring, electronic registration systems, and the application of remote tracking technologies. It also provides for the establishment of technical requirements for fishing vessels, fishing gear, and fisheries infrastructure, as well as the introduction of their registration and control systems, which will help prevent illegal fishing and ensure the efficient use of resources. 4. 対外経済関係

●アゼルゴールドとソマリア開発・復興銀行総裁が協力機会を模索

On June 20, Khayyam Farzaliyev, Deputy Chairman of "AzerGold" CJSC, met with Adam Roble, Director General of the Somali Development and Reconstruction Bank. During the meeting, Adam Roble mentioned the activities of the financial institution he represents and the mineral resource potential of Somalia. He noted that the bank is currently participating in the implementation of a national program aimed at studying, mapping, and restoring historical geological data regarding Somalia's rich underground resources, such as gold, uranium, lithium, and titanium. The Director General highlighted the bank's intention to benefit from the advanced experience of "AzerGold" CJSC in attracting international investors, as well as in the fields of geological exploration and extraction. At the end of the meeting, the parties exchanged views and reached an agreement to continue the exchange of information at the level of structural departments responsible for foreign project development, with the aim of identifying specific future partnership opportunities. ●Azertelecom と telecom Armenia がインターネット接続に関し合意 アゼルバイジャンを通じアルメニア通信網に接続

AzerTelecom and Telecom Armenia signed bilateral agreements enabling the provision of international internet connectivity to Armenia through Azerbaijan.

Under the agreement, AzerTelecom, the region's leading backbone internet operator, will expand the number of countries and its geographical reach in the supply of international internet traffic and will also provide internet traffic transit towards Armenia by leveraging its infrastructure. ●アゼルバイジャンは高中所得国の中で ADB の支援を最も効率的に利用

Azerbaijan has shown the highest result among upper-middle-income countries in the effective use of ADB resources, demonstrating a strong concentration of financing in projects related to regional integration, private sector development, the climate agenda and digital transformation. Azerbaijan received \$2.5 billion in sovereign financing for 10 projects in 2015-2024. More than half of this amount (51%) was directed toward the development of regional cooperation and integration, one of the highest indicators among upper-middle-income countries. Another 39% of the funds was allocated to private sector support, 18% to climate financing and 10% to projects in the field of digital technologies. The report noted that ADB's operations in Azerbaijan's private sector became increasingly focused on achieving economic development goals. During the period, the bank approved nine non-sovereign projects worth a total of \$963.9 million, with all financing directed toward private sector support. At the same time, 78% of non-sovereign commitments were related to regional cooperation and integration projects. According to ADB, this was the highest indicator among comparable upper-middle-income countries. (report.az, 22.06.2026)

●アゼルバイジャン航空社へ 4 機目の A320neo (エアバス社) が納入

AZAL, part of AZCON Holding, has expanded its fleet with another state-of-the-art Airbus A320neo aircraft. The introduction of the new aircraft is aimed at providing passengers with a

more comfortable and modern travel experience Thanks to its new-generation engines, the Airbus A320neo consumes less fuel, reduces carbon emissions, and can operate efficiently on regional and medium-haul routes with a flight range of up to 6,300 kilometers. It should be noted that the new aircraft is the fourth Airbus A320neo in AZAL's fleet of 28 aircraft. With the continuous enhancement of the passenger experience and the expansion of its route network identified as key priorities, AZAL aims to increase its fleet to 50 aircraft by 2032. ●AZPROMO と米代表団が協力機会を模索 アゼルバイジャンのトランジットとしての潜在性等につき議論

On June 22, Yusif Abdullayev, Executive Director of AZPROMO, met with a U.S. delegation led by Abraham Hamadeh, Member of the House of Representatives. Yusif Abdullayev briefed the delegation on Azerbaijan's business and investment environment, mechanisms for promoting foreign direct investment, the agency's areas of activity, and the 2nd Azerbaijan International Investment Forum scheduled to be held in September this year. The AZPROMO Executive Director also highlighted cooperation opportunities between the two countries. The sides discussed Azerbaijan's transit potential, the involvement of U.S. companies in investment projects in the country, the transfer of technology and know-how, the use of financial support instruments, and opportunities for expanding business ties. At the same time, information was provided on the advanced experience gained by the customs services of both countries, and issues related to strengthening cooperation in information technologies, customs statistics, risk management, the organization of customs operations at seaports, and other areas were discussed. Sylapov, who is on a visit to Azerbaijan, familiarized himself with the services provided to citizens at Baku DOST Center No. 1. Presentations were made for him on the DOST Concept and digital services in the social sphere. It was emphasized that there is significant potential for exchanging experience in the modernization of social insurance systems, digitalization of services, and the development of professional training and retraining programs. It was also noted that it would be appropriate to explore cooperation opportunities in the fields of labor protection, social services, employment program development, pension system advancement, and support for vulnerable groups. ●アゼルバイジャン鉄道公社（ADY）が中国から新たに車両 14 両を購入予定 長距離線向けに強み

A delegation from Azerbaijan Railways (ADY) is on a business visit to the People’s Republic of China. As part of the visit, ADY Chairman Rovshan Rustamov met with Chen Zhisi, Head of CRRC Ziyang Co., Ltd., to discuss the modernization of Azerbaijan’s locomotive fleet, the enhancement of rolling stock capacity for freight and passenger transport, and the expansion of bilateral cooperation. The discussions focused on strengthening ADY’s capacity to provide efficient, reliable, and safe transport services amid growing freight volumes along international transport corridors. The parties also explored opportunities for further cooperation in railway technology and fleet development. The two sides also held negotiations on the procurement of an additional 14 locomotives. In addition, ADY and CRRC Ziyang signed an agreement for the purchase of four new mainline passenger locomotives, scheduled for procurement in 2027. The new rolling stock is expected to improve service quality and passenger comfort, particularly on long-distance routes. (Azer News and Azertag, 23.06.2026)

●EU が連結性アジェンダの場で中央アジア・コーカサス及び欧州の連結性強化を推進

The European Commission has launched a “Connectivity Agenda” platform aimed at strengthening links between Europe and Central Asia through the Black Sea region and the South Caucasus. According to the Commission, the initiative is expected to help attract up to €2 billion in investment for transport infrastructure in the region, based on agreements reached with international financial institutions. The platform will serve as a unified framework for coordinating investments and policy measures in the areas of transport, energy, digital connectivity and trade, the European Commission said. Strengthening the operation of the Trans-Caspian Transport Corridor (TCTC) has been identified as one of the initiative’s key priorities. European Commissioner for Enlargement Marta Kos said: “At a time of growing conflict, it is great to see so many countries come together around a shared project. We need reliable trade routes, and the Trans-Caspian Transport Corridor has emerged as exactly that. Trade along the route could increase fivefold over the next 15 years. To make this happen, we need to bring our efforts together. Many projects and initiatives are already under way. The Platform will connect them, fill the remaining infrastructure gaps and link the route from end to end.” (Trend, 23.06.2026)

●カスピ海海底ケーブルプロジェクトが進展 敷設予定の海底ケーブルがアゼルバイジャン・カスピ海海運会社（ASCO）によってカザフスタンのクリク港からバクー港まで輸送完了

As a key component of the Digital Silk Way project, which aims to establish a new digital corridor between Europe and Asia, the submarine cable intended for the construction of the Trans-Caspian Fiber Optic Cable Line (FOCL) was transported from the Kurik port in Kazakhstan to the Baku port by Azerbaijan Caspian Shipping Company (ASCO). The cargo was delivered to the Kurik port by a convoy of three specialized transport vehicles, loaded onto ASCO's ferry vessel, and safely transported across the Caspian Sea to Baku. ●都市計画委員長とトルクメニスタンの産業生産建設大臣が意見交換

Azerbaijan highly values Turkmenistan's support in the large-scale reconstruction and restoration works being carried out in its Karabakh and Eastern Zangazur economic regions, Anar Guliyev, Chairman of the State Committee on Urban Planning and Architecture of Azerbaijan, said during a meeting with Turkmenistan's Minister of Industry and Construction Production, Toyguly Nurov. Guliyev noted that the mosque being built in Azerbaijan's Fuzuli is not only a unique architectural example but also a manifestation of the unbreakable friendship, brotherhood, and shared spiritual values between the peoples of Azerbaijan and Turkmenistan. The project demonstrates the strengthening of humanitarian and cultural ties between the two countries. During the meeting, the current state and future directions of the fraternal and strategic partnership between Azerbaijan and Turkmenistan were widely discussed. The sides particularly considered expanding cooperation in urban planning, construction, and infrastructure, applying modern technologies, and implementing joint projects. (report.az, 23.06.2026)

●アゼルバイジャンが万国通信連合（ITU）執行委員等に立候補

Azerbaijan has submitted its candidacy for membership in the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) Council for the 2027–2030 term, while also nominating a representative for the Radio Regulations Board, Ministry of Digital Development and Transport of Azerbaijan told. The next ITU Plenipotentiary Conference is scheduled to take place in Qatar from November 9–27 this year. (Trend, 25.06.2026)

On June 26, Mikayil Jabbarov, Azerbaijan's Minister of Economy met with Denis Afanasyev, Vice-Governor and Chairman of the Government of the Astrakhan Region of the Russian Federation. They exchanged views on strengthening regional economic relations and expanding cooperation in industry, trade, transport, logistics, humanitarian affairs, and other fields. They also highlighted the importance of strengthening business platforms to further deepen ties between business communities. (Azertag, 26.06.2026)

●アジアインフラ投資銀行（AIIB）がアゼルバイジャンに複数年案件のポートフォリオを提案

The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) is considering financing new projects in Azerbaijan, including the development of railway and port infrastructure, as well as renewable energy initiatives, Kazuhiko Nomoto, AIIB Director General for Partnerships, told journalists on June 26. "We are working on a number of projects under both sovereign and non-sovereign financing. In addition, we are considering holding annual roundtable discussions with the Government of Azerbaijan to jointly develop a multi-year pipeline of prospective projects," Nomoto said. He noted that AIIB places particular emphasis on the development of the renewable energy sector. "We have already provided technical assistance for the Trans-Caspian Green Energy Corridor project (Central Asia–Azerbaijan). We are now working closely with the Asian

Development Bank to prepare the project and aim to implement it on a commercially viable basis as quickly as possible," the bank official said. Speaking about the development of the Trans-Caspian International Transport Route (Middle Corridor), Nomoto said the bank is evaluating projects to modernize Azerbaijan's ports, expand logistics hubs, and upgrade the country's railway infrastructure. He added that promising areas of cooperation between Azerbaijan and AIIB include railway development projects and the expansion of port capacity. "However, most of these initiatives are still at an early stage of preparation, so it would be premature to discuss their details at this point," Nomoto concluded. (report.az, 26.06.2026)
